Extensive programme of hiking trips in 2021

We plan:

- on 1 May a guided hike near the wilderness area Dürrenstein in Styria (main organiser ÖAV section Freistadt,
- on 12 June hike to the forest areas at Lusen in the Bavarian Forest,
